

AFMX Drive In Movie Series Information - Event Policies & Guidelines

To ensure a safe and pleasant experience for everyone, these rules apply to all participants in the AFMX Drive In Movie Series to attend this event. New Mexico State Regulations will be in effect for this event. If you cannot or do not want to comply with these measures, you will not be allowed to participate. Volunteers will be checking every participant in every car, so please be prepared.

We will be enforcing a No Mask, No Entry Rule in addition to the following:

1. No refunds or exchanges. If you cannot use your reservation, we recommend giving it to a friend to use.

2. PARKING RULES:

- a) Due to our parking lot arrangement, no vehicle may back into a space ALL VEHICLES FACE FORWARD.
- b) No passengers allowed in back of pick up trucks.
- c) Large or tall vehicles will be guided to park on the sides or back of the lot.
- d) The decision to direct your car to a specific space is at the discretion of the lot staff.
- e) Once parked, you may not drive away until instructed by event staff.
- f) In following social distancing protocols, cars should be parked with 6' of space between them.
- g) Guests will receive a program and drive in movie rules and policies, FM radio channel, bathroom procedure, and contact number for customer service.
- h) You will be directed to the exits after the movie ends.
- 3. FOR SAFETY REASONS, NO CARS WILL BE ADMITTED AFTER THE LOT IS CLOSED. Lot open/close times are posted on the ticketing website. We suggest arriving early for spaces closest to the screen.
- 4. All films are broadcast and can be heard in your car using your FM Radio. If your car is not equipped with a radio, we recommended bringing one. You cannot tune into the signal with a smartphone. The frequency will be given to you at check-in. There are no loudspeakers.
- 5. NO ENGINE IDLING. Because we park cars closely together, your engine exhaust will affect the safety of others. You may start your engine periodically to keep the battery fresh, but for no more than one minute.
- 6. In the event of a rain forecast, we may announce an event cancellation by 1:00pm on the

day of the event. Your ticket may be used for the rescheduled rain date, to be announced.

- 7. In the event of rain during the movie, please shelter in your car. Cars will not be allowed to exit the lot until it is safe to do so, and only under the direction of Drive-In staff.
- 8. THE FOLLOWING SOCIAL DISTANCING POLICIES HAVE BEEN ADOPTED:
 - a) One parked, you must stay in your car. The adult driving the car is responsible for those in their vehicle. All audience members must stay inside the vehicle at all times. There is no picnicking on the grounds, nor on your car's roof, hood, truck, or truck's bed.
 - b) Your vehicle's left side windows may be opened fully. The right windows may be cracked no more than 2" to allow for better airflow.
 - c) You must remove any trash you bring in or create during the film. There are no public waste receptacles available.
 - d) When outside your vehicle, please be respectful of others' space. We highly recommend staying at least 6' away from others, and encourage wearing a face covering.
- 9. Food service will be available by O'Niell's Pub by either their designated dining rules or for take out during the movie.
 - a) If you would like to show up early and have a drink and a meal, O'Niell's can seat you in the restaurant.
 - b) If you would like to order carhop style you can order through www.Oniells.com or our very own O'Niell's App available through Apple or Android. Ticketholders can place an order up to one week in advance.
 - c) Absolutely no alcohol will be served to cars at the movie. If any alcohol and/or other illegal substances are seen being used/consumed the police will be called and your vehicle will be reported.
- 10. We will have restrooms available at O'Niell's Pub, but we request that ticketholders wear facemasks while entering and exiting the restaurant. Also, no more than two in the restroom at one time will be allowed. Restrooms are located inside the south entrance and to the left.
- 11. There will be photographers/videographers attending and documenting the behind the scenes of this event which will be used for future AFMX promotions.
