

AFME FOUNDATION PRESENTS: THE ALBUQUERQUE FILM & MUSIC EXPERIENCE

The **Albuquerque Film & Music Experience (AFME)** is entering its seventh year as a premier interactive film & music festival, held in Albuquerque, New Mexico. The experience will be held **September 24-29**, **2019**. AFME features domestic and international movies, engaging industry panels and workshops, exciting networking events, parties, live music, and more.

Education and **positive economic development** are key components of AFME's activities and events. Year-round, AFME helps young people explore the film and music industries, participate in the various aspects of production, and provide educational opportunities for those who may wish to pursue professional careers in film, music and related endeavors. In addition, AFME is on course to become a significant, **annual visitor attraction**, while drawing attention to our robust film industry.

Giving equal weight to **music** + **film**, our core philosophy lies in emphasizing the **symbiotic relationship** and **creative equality** between film and music, and recognizing talent and artistry in both.

For 2019, AFME will celebrate **ROAD FLIQX**, highlighting the cinematic and musical expression of the "open road", a metaphor for the search for the enduring spirit of freedom. We will feature movies and their soundtracks with actors, directors, writers, musicians and others that make those films come alive.

The cornerstone of **ROAD FLIQX** will be the celebration of the **50th Anniversary of Easy Rider**, arguably the most recognized and emblematic road flick of all time. Images of Peter Fonda, Dennis Hopper and Jack Nicholson cruising the open roads of America (with New Mexico as its backdrop) to an unforgettable soundtrack by Steppenwolf, The Jimi Hendrix Experience, the Byrds, Roger McGuinn and others, are embedded in the hearts and minds of multiple generations.

And, as Taos, New Mexico was Dennis Hopper's home, the festival will include a motorcycle ride along the route where the movie was filmed and to Hopper's burial site, with a special ceremony to commemorate the anniversary.

We expect **AFME 2019** and the **ROAD FLIQX** experience to be unlike any other, and attract fans and aficionados from all directions.







