AFMX Drive-In Movie Series Information - Event Policies & Guidelines

New Mexico State Regulations will be in effect for this event. If you cannot or do not want to comply with these measures, you will not be allowed to participate. AFMX is mandated to carry out these rules by NM State to protect the public safety for all.

Masks protects you, and your mask protects everyone. As such we will be enforcing a “No Mask, No Entry” rule. Event staff will be checking that all ticketholders have a mask upon entry. No exceptions.

PLEASE NOTE DETAILS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

TICKETING / REFUNDS / EXCHANGES:

- Tickets are \$20 per vehicle. Price does not include the food or beverages.
- All tickets must be purchased in advance. Tickets cannot be purchased at the gate.
- There are no refunds or exchanges. If you cannot use your reservation, we recommend giving it to a friend to use.
- IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED NOT TO PURCHASE TICKETS FROM OTHER SOURCES UNLESS YOU ARE CERTAIN IT IS AN OFFICIAL AFMX/EVENTIVE TICKET.
- By purchasing a ticket, ticket holder agrees to adhere to the New Mexico State Regulations for this event. If they cannot or do not want to comply with these measures, it is understood ticket holder will not be allowed to participate.

LOCATIONS / ENTRANCES / EXITS

Parking lot opens at 7:30pm. Lot closes at 8:30pm. Pre Show at 8:45pm. Film at 9:00pm.

ENTRANCES: There will be one gate for entry on the SOUTH SIDE of O’Niell’s Pub on Silver Ave.

EXITS: There will be three gates for exiting to Silver Ave and Graceland Ave.

COTTONWOOD MALL/HOME LIFE - Moonlight Movies at Cottonwood on Saturday Nights

Home Life Furniture Parking Lot, 10000 Coors Bypass NW- Ste XE100, Albuquerque, NM 87114

ENTRANCE: Enter at Home Life Furniture lot on the EAST end of the parking lot.

EXIT: Please follow designated event staff for exit procedures.

To ensure a safe and pleasant experience for everyone, these rules apply to all ticketholders in the AFMX Drive-In Movie Series at all locations who attend this event.

PARKING LOT RULES

Parking Lot opens at 7:30pm, Lot closes at 8:30pm. Film begins at 9:00pm.

- Lot open/close times are posted on the ticketing website. We suggest arriving early to get the best spot in the area designated by your vehicle size.
- To ensure that everyone can view the screen
 1. front rows are reserved for small vehicles
 2. middle rows are reserved for mid-size vehicles
 3. back and side rows for larger vehicles.
- Due to our parking lot arrangement, no vehicle may back into a space.
- The decision to direct your vehicle to a specific space is at the discretion of the event staff.
- All vehicles must face forward and park in a numbered spot as designated by event staff.
- FOR SAFETY REASONS, NO CARS WILL BE ADMITTED AFTER THE LOT IS CLOSED at 8:30pm.

VEHICLE RULES

- No passengers are allowed in back of pick-up trucks.
- Convertibles are prohibited from having tops down at the drive-in. No exceptions.
- No movie viewing or picnicking outside of the vehicle, including vehicle's roof, hood, or open truck's bed.
- Once parked, vehicles may not drive away until instructed by event staff.
- Vehicles should be parked with 6' of space between them to comply with social distancing rules.
- No engine idling. Because vehicles will be parked closely together, your engine exhaust will affect the safety of others. You may start your engine periodically to keep the battery fresh, but for no more than one minute.
- Headlights must remain off during the movie.
- Ticketholders are not required to wear masks in their vehicle. Masks ARE REQUIRED when exiting vehicles to use restroom facilities or obtain food service.

AFTER THE MOVIE

- There will be three (3) exits for the O'Niell's Pub parking lot.
- Event staff will direct vehicles to the appropriate designated exits after the movie ends.
- You must remove any trash you bring in or create during the film. There are no public waste receptacles available.

FILM BROADCAST

- All films are broadcast and can be heard in your car using your FM Radio.
- Ticketholders will receive the FM radio channel when they enter the parking lot.
- The frequency will be given to ticketholders at gate check-in.
- If your car is not equipped with a radio, we recommended bringing one. You cannot tune into the signal with a smartphone. There are no loudspeakers.

CANCELLATION / POSTPONEMENT

- In the event of inclement weather, we may announce an event cancellation by 1:00pm on the day of the event. Your ticket may be used for the rescheduled rain date, to be announced.
- If there is inclement weather during the event, please shelter in your vehicle. Vehicles will not be allowed to exit the lot until it is safe to do so, and only under the direction of event staff.

SOCIAL DISTANCING POLICIES

- Once parked, ticketholders must stay in your car. The adult driving the car is responsible for those in their vehicle.
- All ticketholders must always stay inside their vehicle .
- There is no picnicking on the grounds, nor on vehicle's roof, hood, or open truck's bed.
- Your vehicle's left side windows may be opened fully. The right windows may be cracked no more than 2" to allow for better airflow.
- When outside your vehicle, please be respectful of others' space. We highly recommend staying at least 6' away from others and wear a face mask.
- Ticketholders are not required to wear masks in their vehicle. Masks ARE REQUIRED when exiting vehicles to use restroom facilities or obtain food service.

FOOD SERVICE

For O'Niell's Pub drive-in movies, food service will be available by O'Niell's Pub by either their designated dining rules or for take out during the movie. Please note the entry fee of \$20 does not include the price of meals from O'Niells.

- Ticket holders may arrive early for meals and drinks at O'Niell's where they can seat you in the outdoor patio area or other designated area, space permitting.
- Ticket holders may also order carhop style prior or during the movie, up to one week in advance through O'Niell's. To order, visit www.Oniells.com:
 1. Select Order Online
 2. Select Nob Hill Location
 3. Select your menu items and proceed to payment at cart.
 4. Select Curbside Delivery. In the special instructions, please provide your cell number and parking space number for proper delivery.
- **Absolutely no alcohol will be served to movie patrons.** If any alcohol and/or other illegal substances are seen being used/consumed, the police will be called, and your vehicle will be reported.

RESTROOM FACILITIES

- Restrooms are available at O'Niell's Pub or Cottonwood Mall.
- All ticketholders are required to wear face masks while entering and exiting the restaurant or mall. No more than two people in the restroom will be allowed at one time.
- At O'Niell's Pub, restrooms are located inside the south entrance and to the left.
- At Cottonwood Mall, please ask event staff for directions.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- Should it be necessary to vacate the premises during the movie, you will be instructed by AFMX staff through the FM Radio transmission.

EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY

There will be photographers/videographers attending and documenting the action behind the scenes at this event which will be used for future AFMX promotions. Your ticket purchase indicates your consent for your likeness to be used in future AFMX promotions.
